




Important: The spout tee requires a 3/16" hole for the anti-twist pin.



Installation Considerations

- For best results, Hansgrohe recommends that this unit be installed by a licensed, professional plumber.
- Please read over these instructions thoroughly before beginning installation. Make sure that you
 have all tools and supplies needed to complete the installation.
- The mounting surface must be finished and made watertight prior to installation.
- For best service of the ThermoBalance valve, the pressure of the incoming hot water and the pressure of the incoming cold water must be equal.
- Models 04124181 and 04125181 require a ½" line to connect the ThermoBalance deck valve to the spout tee.
- **Do not plug either outlet on the ThermoBalance deck valve.** Please note the special piping instruction on page 9 if only one feature is to be installed.
- Model 04124181 only: protection against back siphonage provided by check valve. A second
 check valve is included with the required trim kit.

^{*}Know and follow all applicable local plumbing codes when setting the temperature on the water heater.

^{**}In Massachusetts, the maximum output temperature of the shower valve can be no higher than 112° F.


Install the ThermoBalance deck valve

Install the lower mounting ring and washer. Screw the lower mounting ring to its lowest position.

Insert the rough up through the mounting surface.


Install the upper mounting ring. Tighten it as far as it will go without forcing it. It will stop at the correct mounting height.

Rest the rough on the mounting surface.



Tighten the lower mounting ring.


Tighten the tensioning screws using a screwdriver.



Install the hot and cold supply lines*


 $\ensuremath{^{\star}}$ follow the manufacturer instructions when using flexible hoses.

The hot supply must be connected to the hot inlet and the cold supply must be connected to the cold inlet or the thermostatic mixing valve cannot work correctly!



Wrap the threads on the hot and cold supply pipes with Teflon tape.

Install the hot and cold supplies on the corresponding inlets.




Install the spout tee

Remove the plug, spout adapter, and sealing ring from the spout tee.


The mounting nut and friction washer remain on the

If the mounting surface is very thin, leave the spacer on the tee as well. Otherwise, it may be discarded.



Wrap the threads on the side port plugs with Teflon tape.


Install the plugs.



Insert the spout tee through the mounting surface (1).


Slide the sealing ring over the spout tee. Install the spout adapter (2).

Do not overtighten the spout adapter or damage may result.




Rest the assembly on the mounting surface so that the anti-twist pin goes into the hole.


Tighten the mounting nut by hand.



Tighten the tensioning screws.




Install the spout plug.




Install the hose pull-out set (04124181 only)

Place the handshower holder and sealing ring on the mounting surface.



Install the friction washer, metal washer, and mounting nut.


Tighten the mounting nut. Tighten the tensioning screws.



Feed the handshower hose down through the handshower holder (1).

Snap the two halves of the insert around the hose (2).


Rest the end of the handshower hose in the holder.



Connect the hose pull-out set to the mixing valve (04124181 only)

Wrap the threads on the high pressure hose with Teflon tape (1). Install this end of the hose on the one of the mixing valve outlets (2).

Connect the handshower hose to the high pressure hose (3).




Connect the spout tee to the mixing valve*


Wrap the threads on the outlet line (not included) with Teflon tape.

Install the line on the mixing valve outlet.

Wrap the threads on the line with Teflon tape. Install it on the spout tee.




Connect the spout tee to the mixing valve (04125181 only)


If only one outlet is to be used, **do not plug the second outlet**. Tie ("loop") the two outlet lines together.

Both outlets must be plumbed!

Do not plug the second outlet!

Cleaning Recommendation for Hansgrohe Products

Modern lavatory faucets, kitchen faucets, and showers consist of very different materials to comply with the needs of the market with regard to design and functionality. To avoid damage and returns, it is necessary to consider certain criteria when cleaning.

Cleaning Materials for Faucets and Showers

Acids are a necessary ingredient of cleaning materials for removing lime, however please pay attention to the following points when cleaning faucets and showers:

- Only use cleaning materials which are explicitly intended for this type of application.
- Never use cleaning materials which contain hydrochloric, formic, phosphoric, or acetic acid, as they cause considerable damage.
- Never mix one cleaning material with another.
- Never use cleaning materials or appliances with an abrasive effect, such as unsuitable cleaning powders, sponge pads, or micro fiber cloths.

Cleaning Instructions for Faucets and Showers

Please follow the cleaning material manufacturer's instructions. In addition, pay attention to the following points:

- · Clean the faucets and showers as and when required
- Use the amount of cleaning product and the amount of time recommended by the manufacturer. Do not leave the cleaner on the fixture longer than necessary.
- Regular cleaning can prevent calcification.
- When using spray cleaners, spray first onto a soft cloth or sponge. Never spray directly onto the faucet as droplets can enter
 openings and gaps and cause damage.
- After cleaning, rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove any cleaner residue.

Important

Residues of liquid soaps, shampoos, and shower foams can also cause damage, so rinse with clean water after using.

Please note: if the surface is already damaged, the effect of cleaning materials will cause further damage.

Components with damaged surfaces must be replaced or injury could result.

Damage caused by improper treatment is not covered under the warranty.

Limited Lifetime Consumer Warranty

This product has been manufactured and tested to the highest quality standards by Hansgrohe, Inc. ("Hansgrohe"). This warranty is limited to Hansgrohe products which are purchased by a consumer in the United States after March 1, 1996, and installed in either the United States or Canada.

WHO IS COVERED BY THE WARRANTY

This warranty extends to the original consumer purchaser only. This warranty is non-transferable.

WHAT IS COVERED BY THE WARRANTY

This warranty covers only your Hansgrohe manufactured product. Hansgrohe warrants this product against defects in material or workmanship as follows: Hansgrohe will repair at no charge for parts only or, at its option, replace any product or part of the product that proves defective because of improper workmanship and/or material, under normal installation, use, service and maintenance. If Hansgrohe is unable to provide a replacement and repair is not practical or cannot be timely made, Hansgrohe may elect to refund the purchase price in exchange for the return of the product.

LENGTH OF WARRANTY

Replacement or repaired parts of products will be covered for the term of this warranty as stated in the following two sentences. If you are a consumer who purchased the product for use primarily for personal, family, or household purposes, this warranty extends for as long as you own the product and the home in which the product is originally installed. If you purchased the product for use primarily for any other purpose, including, without limitation, a commercial purpose, this warranty extends only (i) for 1 year, with respect to Hansgrohe and Commercial products, and (ii) for 5 years, with respect to AXOR products.

THIS WARRANTY DOES NOT COVER, AND HANSGROHE WILL NOT PAY FOR:

- Conditions, malfunctions or damage not resulting from defects in material or workmanship.
- B. Conditions, malfunctions or damage resulting from (1) normal wear and tear, improper installation, improper maintenance,

- misuse, abuse, negligence, accident or alteration, or (2) the use of abrasive or caustic cleaning agents or "no-rinse" cleaning products, or the use of the product in any manner contrary to the product instructions. (3) Conditions in the home such as excessive water pressure or corrosion.

When warranty service is completed, any repaired or replacement product or part will be returned to you postage prepaid.
