




Trim Installation


TRIM PLATE & PLATE COVER


- Fit sleeve over valve until it bottoms out.
- Place foam strip around the inner edge of the shower plate.
- Press the shower plate against the wall.
- Screw the 2 plate screws through the plate holes and onto the valve's screw holes. Tighten both screws firmly.
- Fit the plate cover over the sleeve and press it all the way into the trim plate.


HANDLE


- Insert the handle onto the valve stem. Turn the handle clockwise until it reaches the end. Reposition the handle to the desired position. The handle should be facing up at 12 o'clock position.
- Using the provided Allen key, insert the set screw onto the handle and press against the valve's stem. Tightem it firmly.
- Adjust the height of the handle if it is scraping against the shower plate.
- Insert the plug into the handle set screw hole.

LENGTH OF WARRANTY & WHO IS COVERED BY OUR WARRANTY

This warranty extends to the original consumer purchaser only and extends for as long as the original purchaser owns the product and the home in which the product is installed.

WHAT IS COVERED BY OUR WARRANTY

- 1. Finishes: SANTEC Polished Chrome, Polished Nickel and Satin Nickel finishes carry a Lifetime Limited warranty against manufacturing defects and tarnish to the original purchaser with the exclusion of kitchen drain assemblies which, due to the nature of their use, are not warranted. SANTEC recommended custom finishes carry a ten (10) years limited warranty against manufacturing defects and tarnish to the original purchaser with the exclusion of kitchen and pop-up drain assemblies which, due to the nature of their use, are not warranted. Kitchen products carry a three (3) year limited warranty. Both thermostatics and pressure balances carry a fixed (5) year limited warranty.
- 2. Cartridges: Santec cartridges carry a lifetime limited warranty, with the exception of thermostatic and pressure balanced cartridges, which carry a five (5) year limited warranty against manufacturing defects to the original purchaser.
- 3. Parts: Santec parts carry a ten (10) year limited warranty against manufacturing defects, to the original purchaser. Kitchen products carry a five (5) year limited warranty.

EXCLUSIONS AND LIMITATIONS OF WARRANTY

This warranty does not cover:

- 1. Damage due to negligence, accident, abuse, improper installation, or improper maintenance such as, but not limited to: heat from soldering during installation, the use of plumber's putty, damage from tools used during installation, the use or exposure to chemicals or cleaning products either abrasive or non-abrasive, or the use of any cleaning tool or product other than a soft, clean cloth. Reverse osmosis may also shorten the life of the finish.
- 2. Changes in the finish or in the product due to normal wear or aging does not cover any products or parts which have been altered or used in a manner not typical for the product.
- 3. Loss, damages, or expense, incidental or consequential whatsoever, originating from the purchase, installation, use, repair, failure, or replacement of any SANTEC product or part, allowed by law.
- 4. Commercial and/or Industrial installations and use of the product.
